

A better way to hoist logs gains patent

7,011,123 for a device to lift sections of heavy logs has been issued to inventor Byron Peterson of Sequim.

Peterson's invention automatically lifts heavy log sections into place to be split when the splitter ram is retracted.

Innovation Law Group Ltd., 237 N. Sequim Ave. (360-681-7305), assisted Peterson in the drafting, filing and prosecution of the patent, obtaining coverage both as part of a new splitter and as a retrofit kit.

He is now seeking licensees to make and distribute his patented hoist.
